CHILD SAFE UPDATE

The 2018 National DAY FOR DANIEL

The 2018 DAY FOR DANIEL will be held on FRIDAY OCTOBER 26th. Students are encouraged to wear red, and to bring a gold coin donation.

The theme of the day is to wear Red, Educate and Donate. Parents, carers and teachers are asked to start a conversation with children about personal safety. Money raised on the day fund education programs, resource development and support.

We ask people to wear red on Day for Daniel in remembrance of Daniel Morcombe. Daniel was wearing a red t-shirt when he was abducted on 7 December 2003. He was last seen waiting for a bus. Wearing red links Daniel's very real story to the importance of safety education.

Conversations or education does not need to be scary or risk focused but will highlight topics such as recognising body clues that may tell us we are unsafe, understanding body ownership, naming private body parts and identifying adults who can help if a child feels unsafe.
