I have noticed a lot of students riding to school without a helmet.

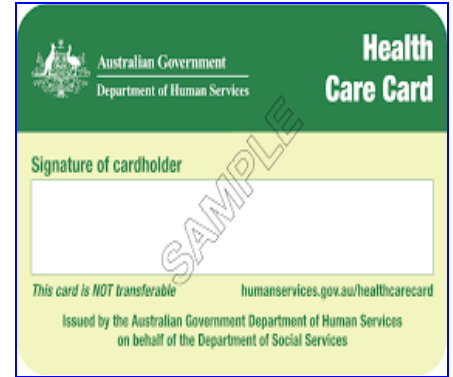
Please make sure they wear a helmet as it is not only the law, but it will protect their head in an accident.

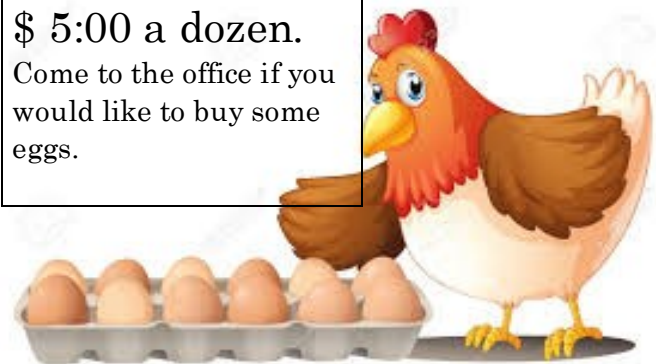
There have many improvements to the school, children's education, playground and a great community.
