As a school we know it is very important to help students **WORK OUT STRONG FEELINGS** or to **CALM DOWN THEN SORT IT OUT**.

Please check in with your child/ren and remind them that it is always okay to feel upset, angry or frustrated, but that we need to walk away and breathe to calm ourselves down, so our brain has time to cool and think about what to do, including getting a teacher to help.



An update about BULLYING

Research has shown that parents have a great influence on preventing bullying. **Please remind your child it is important to respect that everyone is different, and to treat others the way they would like to be treated.** You have more influence than you probably realise! But we also know that we, as teachers, have the opportunity to create and model respectful and positive relationships with all our students. **The more respectful we are, the better our students will learn.** That is why being a PBS school is really important to us!



Green★Room

Children can access the Green Room in a variety of ways. Sometimes a student may have an organised program using the resources in the room. Students are sometimes offered a short play opportunity at lunch or recess. Or, students can use their high five cards to spend time in the room.



The Community Asthma Program (Cap) - Cohealth

A community program that provides free asthma education and support for children and their families with asthma is being run by Cohealth.

An asthma educator works with children and their families to:

- understand asthma, its signs and severity
- identify triggers and learn how to control them
- understand their medications and administer them correctly
- develop a written asthma action plan
- learn asthma first aid / when to seek medical advice

When: Monday to Friday

Time: Between 9.00am - 5.00pm. Sessions usually take 60-90 minutes.
